Saturday Outreach

Each Saturday morning during the college semester we go out with the college students and teens from the church to talk with people about Christ. We always meet interesting people, and we get many different responses to the gospel. People are always very hospitable. Many times as we enter into a family's yard, they will bring out chairs and we will all sit under a tree and have a good time looking at Bible verses surrounding salvation.

A few weeks ago, I talked to a man named Emmanuel. Emmanuel was ready to receive Christ that Saturday morning. He came with his wife Sharon and child to church that next day, on Sunday morning. That morning Sharon also received Christ!

Village Churches

In September, I took a few men out to one of our village churches to help with their baptismal service. Whenever we do this, it takes most of the day. First, we had to wait for their church members to arrive. Then we had a time of singing followed by teaching on baptism. Then we had to walk to the place of the baptism. In this case, it was a stream that was about two miles from the church. The members of the church watched from a bridge while Pastor Bosco and I entered the water to baptize more than 15 people. We then walked the two miles back to church. Then we had more singing and teaching followed by a simple Ugandan meal. It was great to see these new believers take this step of obedience to the Lord.

Radio Ministry

Every Wednesday, I do a live call-in preaching time on Calvary Radio. Last Wednesday I gave the gospel and told the people who were listening that if they wanted to hear more, we would be happy to organize a time to meet with them and talk more about it. On that day, one man named Tom sent me a message saying he would like to know more. I called him and organized a visit; so that Saturday I went with a couple of our college students and teens to go visit Tom. We were able to explain the plan of salvation to him again and answer his questions. Praise the Lord, Tom received Christ that day! It is good to be able to see fruit like this from the radio ministry.

Deaf Ministry

Sara has been trying to visit one of our deaf ladies each week in Gulu. She takes Gabriel along with Nancy, our main deaf interpreter. During one of these visits, they visited a lady named Saida along with her husband. They were talking about salvation. That day Saida's husband Samuel also got saved!
