Trip

As many of you have heard, I was able to take a two-week trip to Uganda at the beginning of the year with Andrew and a man from our sending church. The purpose of the trip was to teach a blocked institute class and to check on how everything has been going in Uganda. Things are going well; it is clear that God's hand is at work.

It is also good to see ministries going on in Uganda while we've been back in America. One of these ministries has been the Bible School in the villages. Some of the notes from past classes have been translated, and they're being taught now in Acholi out in the villages. Also, there has been a renewed desire among our church people to go out, evangelize, and start more churches even while we're on furlough.

It was also encouraging to see the radio station continuing to broadcast the truth of the gospel. On our trip I was able to sit down with our radio manager, Tonny, and discuss various programming. We praise the Lord for what He is doing through Calvary Radio 105.3 fm. We were able to take over four new broadcasting antennae. When installed, these antennae will increase our signal strength, giving us greater coverage and fewer dead spots. Getting them into the country was a bit of a challenge. Customs was demanding a 55% tax to bring them in. Thankfully, after much prayer and a thorough check of the tax code book, we were assessed only a 25% tax. These antennae are now in Gulu, waiting to be installed when we return from furlough!

Our kids are still enrolled at Woodcrest Baptist Academy in Minnesota. They're enjoying being on the sports teams and participating in music and drama activities. We praise the Lord for the opportunities He has given them during this season of our lives.

Also, our son Andrew has begun his second semester at Maranatha Baptist University, and he is enjoying his experience there. Pray that God will continue to guide and protect him during this time in his life. Also, please pray that God will continue to provide for his college expenses.

Praise and Prayer

We praise God that schools have finally re-opened in Uganda, and most of the lockdown restrictions have been lifted. Many of these young people have missed an entire two years of their academic instruction. Please pray for the many youth of Uganda.

We're welcoming in two additional students to the Bible college, Tonny and Daniel. Please pray for these two men as they begin classes at the end of January.

Please pray that our furlough will continue to be all that God wants it to be.
