Over 100 children gathered to hear the Gospel taught by one of our Bible College students. The very next day, families from this community visited our church after transportation was arranged to bring them. We are asking for prayer as we strive to make a difference in the lives of these children. Pastor Josue Andrade is praying for a more permanent solution such as a feeding center or mission work as it is a considerable distance from church.
