Our hearts are filled with thankfulness and gratitude to so many of you who have prayed and have given special offerings to help with the purchase of a van. I have been informed that the market is limited right now for the vehicles we are looking at. We have been advised repeatedly to give it a little more time to find what we are needing. As we wait on the Lord, we rejoice in His blessings—we have had 3 new deaf riders in the past several weeks.
