Dear Friends:

We are writing this letter to give you an important update on our health situation, especially Brenda's.

Her doctors at Cleveland Clinic have been monitoring her liver very closely, so she has been having a scan of her liver and bile ducts every six months. On her most recent scan they found a 1.4 cm lesion on her liver that they believe is cancer. Her doctor presented her case to their tumor board and they are overwhelmingly recommending a liver transplant. The lesion is very small, but because of the disease in her bile ducts they are recommending the transplant while she is younger and in decent health, as the disease in the bile ducts will get progressively worse. We will be pursuing the option of a living donor transplant since this would speed up the process. They will be contacting her soon to start the transplant evaluation and we will be looking for a living donor. Pray that the Lord will lead us to the right match. As amazing as modern medicine is, our trust is in the Lord and we are thankful that we can completely trust Him!

Meanwhile, I (John) plan to have knee surgery on July 31st.

We also received word from Pastor Lovelace in Trinidad that he will be submitting our paperwork for our new missionary permit this week.
