We have talked with her before about her need for Jesus and at that time she was not interested. Also, pray for Katherine their mum, she also needs to be saved.

From December 30 to January 3, we spent time at the North Island Family Camp. This is always a great time hearing what God has been doing around the Island. It was a blessing to see many of the young people who we have taught in the New Zealand Bible Baptist Training Program. This year one of the young men was ordained by his church and is working with a missionary to start a Church in Matamata. The greatest thing during Camp was the night a young person trusted Christ as their Savior. There was also a young man there who is a Care giver to another young man who has Cerebral Palsy and was attending Camp.
