### Furlough Continues



The past few weeks have been full of travel and spending Christmas back at our sending church. December was a busy month as we traveled through Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee, Arkansas, Missouri, Utah, Montana, Washington, and Oregon. Since September of 2023, we have visited approximately 25 states. It has been a joy to meet those who have been supporting us for the past 20 years.

### Fund Raising for Bethlehem Baptist Seminary Buildings

Our focus, as we have been traveling these past few months, has been the need for a new educational building on the conference center property. The current facilities at the conference center do not have any areas for classrooms or adequate dorm rooms. The plans have been drawn up for a two-story building that will house both men's and women's dorms, dorm parents' housing, and classrooms. The estimated cost of the project is \$240,000 US. We have raised \$32,000 since the beginning of our furlough. We are praying that God provides the rest of the needed funding so we can begin construction when we return to Honduras.
