Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for lifting us up in prayer these past 3 months as we have been working on the building construction! And thank you to all of those who are giving faithfully to this project!

In January we started meeting in one of the attendee's homes for Sunday services. But as of the second week of February we have been able to meet in the new church building, although amid a lot of construction materials. The situation changes weekly.

This week we have taken off the auditorium roof in order to hang trusses and get ready for the pouring of the second floor. Since the lot where the building sits is so tight, we needed to build upward for classrooms, as you saw in the video we sent the first of the year. This coming week will possibly be the most exciting yet if we can get the second story floor poured both in the auditorium and the annex, making it possible to then use both these spaces for ministry. We would love to be able to invite folks to the auditorium for a special service the Friday before Easter as well as Easter Sunday. Please pray with us that this will be possible and a great outreach of the Gospel.

We recently had 2000 church invitations printed for Faro de Luz, and one of our folks has made up a strategic plan for delivering these in the neighborhoods. We praise the Lord for a faithful core group of believers with which to start this work, for great receptivity in the area, and for the protection of the construction workers throughout this process. Because the gifts have come steadily for the construction, it has allowed us to not miss a beat in buying materials and paying our workers. Praise the Lord.

Please pray with us for this next phase of construction of the second floor as well as the outreach and giving of the Gospel coming up. We hope that many will receive the Lord as Savior.

Our residency here has been applied for and will be available hopefully by August or so. In Belize news, Pastor Samuel and Elsa now have their Belizean residency and are expecting a baby in July! Many of you have prayed that the Lord would give them a little one.
