We are humbled and very thankful for the opportunity to be here and the partnership that allows us to do so from each of you. We want to send a sincere thank you to each person and ministry that has made this possible for us. To God be the glory, great things He has done!

The last couple months have been very busy with our language studies. We have several hours of class four days a week and study several hours outside of class of the afternoon, evenings and weekends. It is encouraging to understand more of what we read and hear. Speaking is definitely the most difficult and what comes later in the process, but we are getting there. Since we do not have a vehicle here, we use a lot of Ubers and taxis. We do our best to strike up a conversation with our drivers to practice our Spanish. It is always encouraging when they say, 'tu español es muy bueno' (your Spanish is very good). We definitely don't feel that way just yet. We try to leave each one with a gospel tract and most are very receptive. We are thankful that there are tools that we can use to share the gospel truth until we can get more fluent and be a better personal witness. We even carry some tracts in English for that occasional meeting with someone who speaks both languages.

We do want to say how much we appreciate those of you that are so faithful to stay in touch and reach out to us. We are thankful to be "gone but not forgotten." Some extra financial gifts from the holidays have continued to come into our account this month and we wanted to say thank you again to those of you who have given so generously to be a blessing to us and help us be in our place.

The gentleman who owns the language school has given us the opportunity to start a Bible study in the morning before classes begin. Please pray with us as this is a unique opportunity. The Bible studies will be in English so many people may come who just want to learn more English. There are also students here from all over the world that speak some measure of English. May God use us to reach those from other nations as well as Colombia. We also ask for continued prayer for the language learning process and the ability to use it effectively. May each of us, in whatever ministry we are found, keep our focus on the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
