UKRAINIAN REFUGEE UPDATE Over the past month, we have been able to provide lodging and supply needs for about 30 Ukrainian refugees, mostly women and children. Some have stayed at our school, The Baptist College International, while others have found refuge with individual families and Christian foundations. Relief funds were sent to aid these worthy efforts. Also, provisions and meals were prepared for local refugee centers and for about 300 in transit by bus.



There were 22 refugees with our church the last weekend of March from Baptist churches in Ukraine. We took their teens on a karting activity with our youth group on Saturday, then they all participated in Sunday services and shared their struggles and how we can better pray for them and for their nation. **PRAY FOR UKRAINE!**



Last week, thanks to so many responses to our appeal for help, we participated in the shipment of needed medical supplies, water purification systems and various dry goods to Odessa to assist a fellow missionary and his church to further minister to the needs of those under attack. A total of over \$5000 of goods were purchased and then loaded into several vans which were being driven into Ukraine at the southernmost border with Romania.

Also, we were able to send \$1200 to a former student of our Bible college who is now ministering in a Baptist church in Sighetu-Marmației right on the westernmost border of Romania with Ukraine. They have made several trips into UA over the past month to deliver needed supplies and have also brought people back to Romania and have housed and fed them at their church, which has their entire basement converted to a refuge center.

Tracts for refugees

Through the generosity of our local printer, a few thousand tracts have been printed to share the Gospel with Ukrainian refugees. We included one with each meal, placed several at a refugee center, and offered them to Ukrainian Christians to pass on. Each has a contact number of a Ukrainian missionary to Moldova that we support who would be able to help them further. We also received a box of Ukrainian Chick tracts from a missionary in Germany. Pray for the seed to take root in the hearts of these dear souls
