

Ministries

I am so thankful that ministries are continuing in my absence in Peru. Calvary Baptist Church is growing and continues to see people saved, baptized, and disciplined in the Word of God!

We are also continuing with the building project for the Christian school. We have been able to connect the water, sewer and electric services for the land, and we are beginning the construction of the security wall around the playground area in the next few weeks. We originally planned to build temporary classrooms in order to start the kindergarten program in March of 2023. Because of my health, and city approval delays we will not be able to have that construction completed in time, but this delay gives us more time to consider building a permanent structure for the first phase of the building. The permanent building would include three classrooms with bathrooms and

an office space. The permanent building will cost about \$30,000 more than the temporary classrooms would, but they will have all the structure in order to build the second and third story classrooms we would need in the next 5 to 10 years. The temporary classrooms would have to be demolished to build the needed structures in the future. I am praying that God will show me which building plan to use and provide for the expenses of the project. We currently have \$31,400 for the building project. If we only build temporary classrooms we would be just under \$4,000 away from our goal. I am praying that God will provide the additional \$30,000 that we would need over this next year in order to build the permanent structures. Health Update

I am continuing to receive treatment for the ovarian cancer that I was diagnosed with in May. I have had 6 chemotherapy treatments so far. The side effects of these treatments have included fatigue, nausea, neuropathy, and hair loss. I am thankful that these reactions have been mild, and have decreased the tumors to the point that I will be ready for surgery. My surgery is scheduled for Friday, September 30th. Please pray especially on that day. I will also need at least 3 more chemotherapy treatments after the surgery to make sure that I am in full remission. Please pray that I can get to that point quickly and that there will be no reoccurrence of the cancer. I still hope to be ready to return to Peru in January or February of 2023! Several churches have sent offerings to help with the medical expenses that my insurance will not cover. I will have a maximum out of pocket expense for the year of \$7,000. I want to praise the Lord for the \$4,500 that has already been given toward that expense. Thank you for your prayers and financial help during this health crisis.
