Prayer letter, April – June

After being out of the country for four months, home has never felt so sweet (and so big after being in a trailer for much of the time we were away)! As good Canadians, the first place we stopped when we got back to Canada was Tim Hortons, followed by a poutine for dinner (two Canadian staples, Ehhh-men!).

As the month of April ended, we finished up our meetings in Virginia and North Carolina. The first day of May we finally made it home and hit the ground running with more meetings in Canada, two of which were Missions Conferences. Both churches took us on for support - we praise the Lord for this!

One of the Missions Conferences that we were a part of in May was at Crosspoint Baptist Church in Ottawa. We were greatly encouraged by this church to see their desire to see more churches started in their city! Just being in the city in which we will start a work for God, and being around God's people who want to see a work for God accomplished has greatly encouraged our hearts! I have never been so eager and excited to get to the field where God has called us to! I can't help but think, there is indeed a people residing in this city that are awaiting the life-changing message of the Lord Jesus Christ!

The month of June consisted of some local meetings as well as a two-week trip away from home, visiting churches in two provinces and two states. We traveled to Ohio, up to eastern Ontario, Montreal, and Vermont. I am encouraged that no matter where we go in our journey the Lord is always with us.
