Financial Month

Every February is "Financial Month" in our church here in Gulu. Every week in the Sunday service, we discuss what the Bible teaches about finances. It is a good reminder each year of the value of tithing, saving, living on a budget, etc. Money can be a big source of marriage problems, even here in Gulu; so February is always a great month.

Missions Team

In April we were able to host a team from a church in Alabama. They were visiting several missionaries in their time here, and we were only able to be with them for about one day. During that time though, they were able to sing live on the radio. I don't know how, but we were able to pack all 17 of them and a couple of others into the studio to sing. Then one of the men preached the simple plan of salvation on the radio, going right through the Romans Road.

While he was preaching on the radio, the rest of the team paired off with people from our church to go out for doorto-door soul winning. It was a great time, and we were able to talk to many people about Jesus. Although the group had to leave, the next Sunday we had around eight visitors that came to our church as a result of the soul winning.

Soul Winning Program

I have wrestled with how to conduct our weekly soul winning program here at our church. I have swung from doing it every week all the way over to not doing it at all. There was a season when I didn't really want to go out soul winning. Each Saturday, I would simply grab a handful of tracts, and as soon as I had handed them all out, I would go directly back home as soon as I could. I am not the best soul winner, but I see it in the Bible and I know that God blesses our obedience.

Right now we go out for soul winning every Saturday during the 12 Saturdays of each Bible College semester. Each Saturday morning, we meet at the church and pair up in teams. My main goal each Saturday morning is to simply find at least one person with whom I can sit down and open my Bible and go through the Roman's Road with. This schedule of door-to-door soul winning has been really good for me.

The next aspect that I want to add to our Saturday morning soul winning program is that of a neighborhood Bible club, where we would have prepared programs and Bible lessons. We would enter into a neighborhood, gather the kids, preach the gospel to them, and invite them to come to our Children's Church.
