Dear Friends:

Thank you for praying for us and supporting us, and thus enabling us for almost 30 years to take the gospel to an area that you were, for the most part, unable to go except through your prayers. Last week I spoke with Pastor Lovelace of Trinity Baptist Church (TBC) in Trinidad, and he gave me the following report. TBC recently ordained Kieron Wilson, who is a humble and submissive man approaching 40 years of age. Pastor Lovelace is 73 years old and is still at TBC, where we and others had the privilege of installing him as national pastor in 2004. We then left this church and went on to Amazing Grace Baptist Church, where we served until 2013 when national pastor, Ricardo Joseph, assumed the pastorate. From 2013 to 2020 we assisted at Hope Bible Baptist Church and Family Baptist Church, as well as starting Anchor Baptist Church. All these churches are continuing today under the same national leadership that God led us to put in place when we left. Some of these churches are starting new ministries and all have done a good job taking care of their church properties. We thank God for all HE has done.

Please pray for Brenda's health as her previously mentioned August 30<sup>th</sup> surgery had to be postponed due to severe anemia. She has had very, very serious digestive problems for close to four years, which often keeps her up many hours of the night. This, of course, takes a serious physical toll on her body, as it is also coupled with a somewhat restrictive diet. Another surgery is planned for her on December 4<sup>th</sup> at Cleveland Clinic, which we all hope will help her tremendously. Her new liver seems to be doing well, and this next surgery is digestive related, not liver.

My cancer seems to be under control at the present time and my next scan is scheduled around January 20<sup>th</sup>. I usually feel fairly well and have not had chemo for a couple of years. Please pray for Brenda especially as these have been very trying times for her. We are depending upon you to pray.
