Dear Praying Friends,

With the season of summer upon us our daily life has changed a bit. School is out and we are enjoying the great outdoors. Although we have nice weather all year, the summer months of July to September are especially beautiful. Last year was exceptionally dry, but this year the rains have seemed more normal again. We have so much looked forward to things turning green. Our farmers save a lot of money and labour when they can shut off the irrigation systems. They earn a decent living when the harvest does well, but wage earners have a difficult time financially. Of our remaining children at home, the oldest four are working hard trying to earn money in this base economy. Prayers for wisdom and supply are much appreciated as they grow more independent each day.

We just finished our annual family camp in the beautiful Sierra Madre. About an hour west of where we live is where the more dense and rugged mountains begin. The camp is located on a very large cattle ranch about one hour's drive from the nearest town. We had a good turnout with some first-time visitors. God blessed us with spectacular weather and great preaching all week. Decisions were made following the messages and everyone was encouraged. In a time where the family unit is so fractured all over North America, this is a very important ministry. On the Sunday following the camp we had a night of highlights being featured with a presentation. Visitors were encouraged to come, and we were blessed to see a family attend for the first time. Following the service we had a good chat and it turns out this family is searching for a church. I was a bit surprised as most people in this area already belong somewhere. He told me the reason was because they were looked down upon where they had been going. We as churches need to remember always the admonition to treat all people equally. My prayer is that they will find this a church to meet their needs.

A family that has been attending for about half a year had expressed strong interest in joining the church. Finding that they met the Scriptural qualifications, we proceeded to accept them into the membership a couple of weeks ago. Over time we have seen a lot of visitors in church, but at this point our congregation is composed mostly of members who are quite faithful. How thankful we are for what God is doing!

Over the last while there have been several souls saved as a result of our outreach program. We praise God for this! It is so encouraging to see our people faithful in witnessing.
