Austin Mark Caviness was born on May 26. He was 8 lbs. 2oz, 21 inches long and he has already stolen our hearts. Both mom and baby are healthy and doing great! Micah loves being a big brother and Austin is already his buddy.

The Lord has been so good to us throughout many unforeseen challenges this summer. I have heard my dad say many times that every miracle began as a problem. When we had to transition back to Oregon for the summer, he miraculously gave us the perfect place to live in a way that could only be Him. Through Kelci's unexpected health problems and the birth of our son, He placed us near family and the medical care she needed and provided for us so we were left with no medical bills. Just recently, I was trying to learn to ride a motorcycle before moving to Congo, where they are a widely used form of transportation. I had a minor accident while learning and badly broke my wrist. I just underwent surgery to place a titanium plate and screws. I am now recovering from the surgery and also from a case of covid that I believe I picked up at the hospital.

I guess you could say it has been one problem after another and for that, strangely enough, we are thankful. We have seen countless opportunities for God to work on our behalf and in our lives. He has miraculously provided, blessed, and grown our faith at every step. I do not know what challenges we will face down the road, but I truly believe that the Lord has used the events of this summer to grow and prepare us.
