As the 2024 year comes to a close, so does our furlough. This furlough lasted twenty weeks and had us travel to 30 States and report in 52 churches. We have counted it a privilege to fellowship with each of our churches as we continue to minister together for the sake of the Gospel. We are making final preparations for our return to Perú. God revealed Himself to us these last two months by answering our prayers: the fires in Perú have subsided, the church continues to grow, and our old car (that was not running on all cylinders) arrived back to our kids in Wisconsin safely.

We took a plane to begin our meetings in churches out West by first flying to Montana, then Vancouver, and lastly to Arizona, where my Dad and I went out looking for a reliable, used car to finish our furlough. God provided a 2019 Infinity vehicle, allowing us to drive to our meetings in California, Nevada, Texas, Kansas, Tennessee and back to Michigan.



Our sending church will be having a special sending off service here at the end of December. We will spend Christmas with all four of our children in Wisconsin and depart for Perú on December 29<sup>th</sup>. We will be taking an eleven-hour night bus trip back to the jungle on December 30<sup>th</sup>, which will be during our rainy season.

We are praying that my passport comes in time. We only have one day when the DMV is open to register the used car in our son's name before leaving. Two car insurances have cancelled our policy these last couple of months due to the deer hitting Nathan's car in August. We are praying that we can get the insurance settled before we leave the country. Even though the plane allows luggage to be a certain weight, the bus restrictions are stricter, meaning we will have a short time to find a way to ship our luggage to the jungle when we arrive. We are praying that God will allow a strong finish to the year and our furlough, as well as for our return to Oxapampa. We continue to pray for our daughter-in-law's green card and resident papers to come.

We praise the Lord for the many blessings that took place while on furlough and for all of you showing us your support and generosity. Our land fund is now up to \$45,011.71, much of it raised thanks to offerings this furlough. Please pray with us that God will allow us to reach the goal of \$100,000 to purchase the right piece of property before it is sold.

We hope that you are also able to finish the year strong and begin the New Year with a renewed hope in Christ.
