Dear Praying Friends,

Thank you for the opportunity to report on what is going on here. We appreciate hearing from you as well. Several cards and greetings were sent to family members who had birthdays these last months. We have them almost every month of the year, so we get to eat cake on a regular basis. ☺ The younger kids are back in school and keeping my wife on her toes, Virginia has enrolled many piano students again, and Bethany had a launch date of October 1 for publishing her second novel. Joseph gets more responsibility at his work each day, and Emily is progressing in her music studies. The kids are using what they learn to serve in church and are a great asset to the ministry. We look forward to seeing our married children and grandson in a couple of weeks when they visit from Canada.

The family that had begun attending church, as mentioned in our last letter, is now in the rehab center. Their enrollment came as a surprise to us and was due to the encouragement of the man's employer. I expect them to return to church, though, as they were very happy to be attending here.

We recently had an opportunity to evangelize in two towns about an hour from our church. Our main outreach is to the Mennonite people, but we take opportunities where God opens doors. There is great need everywhere, and there is no active church in either of the communities we visited. One set of meetings was a repeat of a similar effort last year. The people were more receptive this time around, as though there was a greater trust factor. We saw souls saved and the following Sunday a man from those meetings visited our church. During the invitation he indicated that he was interested in being saved, and he accepted Christ following the service.

We continue to visit in the Mennonite campos each week, and recently had a family visit church as a result. They returned the following week, and we plan to do a follow-up visit shortly. We have also begun using a WhatsApp group chat to invite people to listen to messages we post. As a result, we have seen an increase in views on YouTube and on Sermonaudio.com.

Mexico celebrated Independence Day on September 16. The Mennonites do not celebrate due to their philosophy. Though this land has a reputation for corruption and violence, we have not noticed too much in our area. The beginning of October marked a change in the presidency. We as a country have elected our first female president, Claudia Sheinbaum. The government here is not God-fearing and needs prayer.
