We send you warm greetings from the Dominican Republic. We are so thankful for you, who are our family in the Lord. “For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.” (Matthew 12:50)

Thank you so very much for your prayers for us during our hard time after the fire in our home. Thanks so very much for the special offerings that many sent us to help us off-set these unexpected expenses. We had to move because of different issues with the fire, so we moved into a beautiful house in a nice, gated community only five minutes from our church, which is closer than we have ever been before. We are so thankful for that since the traffic here seems to get worse with each passing day.

Our summer camp is coming up soon from July 29 through August 1, 2024. Camp has always been the activity in our ministry that has given us the best opportunity to “confirm our churches” in the Lord. (Acts 15:41). Three of our pastors who we sent out from our church were called to preach at camp, others have been called who are training for full-time ministry presently, and many other great decisions have been made at camp. The Lord gave us the highest attended camp we ever had last year with 319 present, 35 saved, 16 baptized, 25 called to serve the Lord full-time, and 35 who came forward and said that God had called them before, but they wanted the Lord and everyone to know that they were still going that direction with their lives. Camp is \$55 per camper this year, and we are praying that the Lord would provide us with \$10,000 to help pay for some folks who need help to be able to go to camp.
