Expanding Missions in Central America

A few years ago, we were asked to join a team of national pastors and missionaries to help form a mission agency. This agency is dedicated to aiding families that have been saved, baptized, and trained in Central America. The end goal is to allow them to be able to raise support in their region of the world. This agency aids in the logistics of working with the financial and legal challenges of having five countries in which to do deputation. This year, six new families joined as new missionaries with ABIL Missions! We now have missionaries going to Honduras, Guatemala, Nicaragua, El Salvador and Africa!



Return to the States to Meet with Doctors

Before we returned to Honduras, the doctors revealed that our son, Alejandro, is losing the hearing in his right ear. After preliminary testing, we were asked to return to the States for more in-depth testing to determine if he is a candidate for a cochlear implant. We have finished the testing and are waiting for preapproval from insurance and for the hospital to set his surgery date. We are praying that we can schedule his surgery for early 2025. We are hoping to be able to return to Honduras to participate in the seminary graduation activities as well as to be present for the birth of our first grandchild.
