They are joining together with the other independent Baptist missionaries and their churches to go tent camping up in the Pine Ridge Mountain area. Please pray that God would move in a great way during those days. We're expecting about 100 campers and praying for fewer scorpions than that ;-). Although our kids have killed at least four in our house in the last two days, so they're confident they can handle it :-)
