SEASONS OF LIFE

It is understood that everyone experiences similar seasons of life with births and deaths in the family, but for the Tylers both came at the same time at the end of May this year. Within 24 hours of when Tim's father went to heaven, their daughter, Bethany, gave birth to Dorothea Ivy. God's love and grace were felt in both situations, and brought us much comfort.

Following our return to Romania in June, we continued summer planning and began a busy camp season. One after another, there were 4 camps: Ukrainian families, Adolescents, Teen, and Men & Boys camps.

In August, we were able to take a week in Ireland for our 40th Wedding Anniversary and came back rested and refreshed; just in time to make preparation for the 2024-2025 school year at the Baptist College International. This year we have 5 first-year students.

September was a busy month of ministry at the college and at our church in Timisoara with new Sunday School classes, growing youth and singles ministry and the start of a new year of Christian Children's Club. At the first CCC, there were over 30 children and 8 first-time visitors. We also restarted the afterschool program for Ukrainian families who need safe care of their children during the week while parents work later hours (mostly mothers whose husbands had to stay in Ukraine). This has built a good trust that has brought several of them to attend church.

Modular Project

We have purchased a double bathroom modular and are making an order for a new triple-wide classroom modular that we found at a great price. Our people have given sacrificially for these modulares, and we are paying a 30% advance on the classroom, but need to raise the rest before delivery in November.
