Dear Prayer Partners,

This update is arriving much later than it should, sorry about that. As usual, it's simply because we have been very busy, but we praise the Lord for all he is doing. We'll do our best to get a more detailed prayer letter out next week, but we wanted to take a moment to thank you for your prayers.

I (Nathan) am wrapping up a five day Bible conference in Peru. It has been a blessing to gather with missionaries from several different countries and many pastors here in Peru who have a real love for the Word of God. Most, if not all, have made sacrifices to stand for the pure Word of God in the Spanish language. I also have to thank my wife for allowing me to come while she kept the kids at home (flying with the family was simply too expensive to consider).



I am constantly encouraged by the men at the church in San Pedro who continue to grow in their abilities to preach, teach, and lead the church forward in my absence. Honestly, one of the things I'm looking forward to about taking furlough in 2026 is seeing how the local church will grow in my absence and learn to depend much less on me. Not that I want to work myself out of a job, but that there are many other places in Chile that need a good Bible preaching church. As I work myself out of the job in San Pedro, I will have more time to focus on the church in Cañete and eventually even on other cities that need the gospel. Please continue to pray for the growth of the churches and the need for more laborers and more churches throughout all of Chile.

We enjoyed seeing my (Nathan's) parents for a few weeks in early August and now we get to look forward to seeing Christine's parents around Christmas. God is so good to us!

While my parents were here, they helped us move into our house that we were able to build just outside San Pedro. Our family of 8 no longer fit in the house we had in the city and we are thankful for God's provision of a place with more room for the kids, both inside and outside. There's still much to be done in moving houses, and not much spare time with all the ministry needs and homeschooling going on at the same time. But we praise the Lord for allowing us to make this move, which also gets us a little closer to Cañete.

Thank you, again, for your prayers. We are in a spiritual battle, but we are on the winning side!
