### Radio Programming

During our break in between college semesters one of my goals has been to learn our high-powered radio software more thoroughly. So far we've only been using a part of its potential. This task has included wading through all the thousands of songs that we have inherited over the years and organizing them into proper folders. I've also been deleting a lot of the songs; please pray for wisdom as I continue to work on this project. Our prayer is that everything that goes out over our radio waves will bring glory to God and help people who would not hear of Christ in any other way.

Also, as we traveled on furlough we were telling churches we needed to raise \$500 to run the radio station each month, and we praise the Lord for what has been coming in. Many people gave for one-time purchases, and a couple are giving to monthly needs. We haven't yet raised \$500 per month, but the Lord has been providing. However, since then the costs of running the station have really climbed. When we increased our broadcasting wattage, our electricity bill also went up. Our insurance went up. We've had other expenses also climb, but at this point running the radio station is costing almost \$900 each month. This does not include one-time purchases for equipment. We really need to raise more money that is designated for the radio station; please pray with us about this.

### Deaf Fellowship

Recently, we had a young man from America visit us who is interested in working with the deaf on the mission field. Through his visit we were able to host our first deaf fellowship where we invited every deaf person in Gulu to come to Kica Baptist Church for an evening of games and teaching. Fifteen deaf came, including a few visitors and a few who already come to church. One of the main teachings was on salvation. Like many people in Gulu, some of the deaf visitors had been taught that salvation is something that has to be earned; please pray that these deaf visitors would indeed understand and receive God's free gift of salvation.

### Family Life

Please continue to pray for Susanna, Caleb, and Daniel. We have seen all three of our younger kids grow in the Lord over this last year, and our hearts have been encouraged by it. Please pray as we continue to make educational decisions for each of them that will best meet their unique needs here on the mission field.

As we mentioned in our last prayer letter, it looks like we will be needing to make at least one trip back to the States each summer for the next three years because of kids graduating from college, entering college, or even getting married! We're due for a regular furlough next year. Although we want to visit as many of you as we can, it looks like we may not be able to stay in the States for an extended period of time next year or on any of these trips. Please pray for us as we seek God's will on how to navigate these shorter, more frequent furloughs.

We've entered a season when meeting the needs of our children has just become much more expensive, so please pray with us about these financial needs. Please pray God will continue to show us clearly what is right for our children and how to budget to meet the corresponding financial needs. Throughout the years God has always given us what we've needed, and we know He will be faithful to do it again and again throughout this season of life!

### Praise and Prayer

- Pray for the Bible college students over their break as well as the men who will be coming to the Bible school in September. Pray that they will be faithful to walk closely with the Lord in their village communities.
- Pray for the continued development of our children's church workers; we praise the Lord for those who have stepped up and are learning to teach. A couple of these may be leaving us soon to pursue higher education, so our need for teachers is continuous.
