We are still getting used to our "sea legs" as this letter is typed, but we are thrilled to be back home safe after an amazing boat trip to Haiti just last week! As many of you are aware, Haiti is a country wrapped in darkness and instability. The president was assassinated in the previous year, and rival gangs rule the capitol's streets. Last year, an earthquake ripped through the country, adding more tragedy to an already bleak situation. For the first time, Medical Missions Outreach partnered with My Sea Hope to escort 12 medical professionals from Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic to Jacmel, Haiti. We slept on board with 24-hour security and spent our days assisting Hosanna Baptist Church and Pastor Cherubim in an attempt to serve the community through mass food donations and medical care. We were able to see over 850 patients, with 60 professing Christ as Savior. Despite seasickness and harsh conditions, the Lord kept us safe and full of joy! We are happy to be on dry land again, but still heartbroken over what we saw in Haiti. Please pray for Haiti and the three surgical candidates we are assisting to find help.

Is it March already? How quickly time passes when we stay busy serving the Lord! January found us in Merida, Mexico, for the first time, working with multiple churches amongst the Mayan people. Veteran missionary Jeff Carney was an amazing host, and we were thankful for 843 patients and over 50 salvations. Our team ophthalmologist arranged for special glasses for a little girl who was nearly blind. Her life will be drastically improved with her new glasses!

Last month, our team visited Truth Baptist Church in Santa Barbara, Honduras. This was our second time working with this church plant out of Beacon Baptist Church, and we were thrilled to open services with them in their new building! Pastor Alex Reyes and his church family worked hard alongside our team of 24 volunteers, and we are happy to report that we saw 1591 patients and had 84 professions of faith. We are so thankful for our continued partnership with Beacon Baptist Church in El Progreso and for the lives being impacted in that area.

April is going to be our busiest month yet! We celebrate our Homecoming on April 1st at our new office and warehouse space! All are invited to come and see what God has done in our ministry. All glory goes to Him. Our surgical team will head down to the Rearick Surgical Center in April to do orthopedic surgeries. Please pray for supplies, personnel, and the gospel to go forth. We also have a trip to the Dominican Republic scheduled for the end of the month.

As always, we thank you for your prayers and support. We are in awe of what the Lord continues to do through Medical Missions Outreach. Stay tuned; there is more to come!
